Round/Format

Archers will be able to shoot a Double York for the men and a Double Hereford for the women. A selection of Bristol rounds and Double Nationals will also be available to shoot.

Entry fee

£60 (for all weekend) £48 (for Saturday and Sunday)

Event timings

- Friday National Rounds: registration and equipment inspection from 12pm, sighters at 1pm.
- Saturday: registration and equipment inspection from 9am, sighters to start at 10am.
- Sunday: sighters to start at 9am.
- Once your equipment has been inspected, you will not need to do this again throughout the weekend.

Prizes

- The GNAM 'Spiders' will be awarded as well as the 'Double Distance' silver 'Spiders'.
- Six handicap medals are awarded based upon the handicap quoted by the archer at the beginning of the event, and there will be 30 the challenge trophies. Amongst which are the Double National Score, and some extra awards for achievements such as most hits and best gold.
