Rules

- At each event every archer will accumulate points based on your placing in both the qualification round and head-to-head eliminations. These points will count towards determining the overall JAS category Champions. Results from the stages along with the current ranking for the series will be published online following the event.
- Each phase of the competition must be completed in order for an archer to receive the points. If they retire before the completion of the qualification round, they will not receive the points for it. Likewise, if they drop out of qualification but continue to shoot the head-toheads, they will not get points for either phase of the competition.
